<i>Proposed Access shall be staked at both ends of proposed culvert</i>	

The following construction standard and general requirements shall apply to any culvert placed within the right-of-way and to any paved driveway approach with the right-of-way:

- a. Only one (1) access point shall be allowed per parcel. Driveway shall be a minimum of five(5) feet from lot line.
- b. Only new galvanized steel meeting minimum State Highway gauge will be allowed. Minimum size shall be fifteen (15) inch diameter, thirty (30) foot long, with end pans.
- c. Culverts shall be laid on a bedding of three-quarter (3/4) inch road gravel and shall be backfilled with three-quarter (3/4) inch road gravel. There shall be a minimum of six (6) inches of road gravel covering the culvert.
- d. Driveway grades shall be placed in a manner to maintain a pitch of one-half (1/2) inch per foot away from the roadway to the center of the ditch flow line.
- e. No concrete surface shall be allowed within the highway right-of-way.
- f. The applicant shall be responsible to call the Diggers Hot Line and any other underground utility sufficiently prior to the commencement of excavation to permit proper marking of the area.
- g. The applicant shall restore the highway right-of-way, to the satisfaction of the Town Board, and as soon as possible in order to avoid a hazard to the traveling public and excess erosion. No material shall be placed in the Town right-of-way and obstruction of drainage shall be prohibited.
- h. All work within the right-of way shall be performed in such a manner so as not to interfere with traffic on the adjoining roadway.
- i. The entire cost of installing and maintaining the driveway access and culvert, including restoration, shall be the financial responsibility of the applicant.
- j. The applicant agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Town of Rubicon, its officers, agents and employees against any loss or damage for any personal injury or property damage sustained by reason of the exercise of this permit.
